REGULATIONS

Made by the Commissioner of Police with the consent of the Minister of Works and Infrastructure under section 67(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME) (ARIMA) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2015

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation (Experimental Scheme) (Arima) (No. 2) Regulations, 2015.
- 2. These Regulations shall commence on Monday 10th August, Duration 2015 and expire on Monday 9th November, 2015.
 - 3. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on the— No parking
 - (a) western side of De Graff Street, between Pro De Verteuil Street and Cocorite Road on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays; and
 - (b) eastern side of De Graff Street, between Pro De Verteuil Street and Cocorite Road on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.
- 4. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed along De Graff One-way Street, between Pro De Verteuil Street and Cocorite Road, in a traffic southerly direction only.
- 5. Any person who contravenes these Regulations is liable on Offence and summary conviction for a first offence to a fine of seven hundred and penalty fifty dollars and on any subsequent conviction to a fine of one thousand dollars.
- 6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the Removal and commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in impounding contravention of these Regulations may be removed by the Police and of vehicles impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the parked Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
